Up until now, our composite restorations have been applied *in* the tooth. The technique taught in this course allows us to go *around* the tooth. Injection molding of composites using modern preparations, super-anatomic clear matrices, and heated multi-viscosity composite can solve numerous problems without resorting to crowns.

The Bioclear technique has established a third restorative modality: Monolithic Restorations.

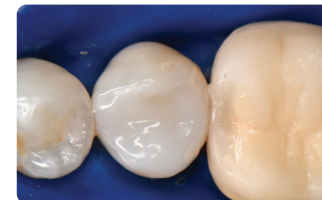
Direct composites are often underappreciated in today's world of implants and computer-assisted ceramics. Yet composites can, in many cases, be less invasive and more natural. Esthetic treatments—including diastema closure, black triangle closure, and Class II, III, and IV composite restorations—are just the beginning of what can be achieved with the Bioclear Technique.
